What should I expect?

Expect to find a place where you can grow in your walk with Christ. MHBC is a place of worship, growth, and opportunity. Our services appeal to individuals of all ages, providing occasions for involvement and service for many different gifts and interests. We believe that God made everyone with unique abilities, and that there is a place for everyone to glorify Him within the Church.

Expect to find a place where you will learn. We have many Bible Study classes for children, youth, and adults that meet on campus. You can see a complete listing of adult classes in our Bible Study brochure located in the Welcome Center. The volunteers there will be able to help you find the best fit for you.

Expect to find a place where your children will be safe. If you come by our Welcome Center, the greeters there will show you where to take your children. Our nursery is always clean and safe. All of our children workers are well qualified, vetted, and will love your children. Security cameras are located in all of our children and youth areas.

What should I wear?

You don't need to dress any specific way. Our Sunday morning services usually have a semicasual atmosphere. It is not uncommon to see people wearing suits and ties, dresses, skirts, pants, or jeans. Our evening services are more casual.

How early should I arrive?

It usually works best for visitors to arrive between 10 to 15 minutes before the service begins so you can find a place to park, drop off your children if needed, and get to the worship service or Bible study classes.

Where should I park?

We have parking places reserved for our new visitors to MHBC. These areas are located in the front of the building and are clearly marked.

Finally, you should come expecting to meet with God and worship with friendly people.
